- C. SPEAKER: Maria thanked Anne Tiffany for inviting her long-term friend and former colleague Thelma Shoneman to present today's program, "Floral Designs Come in All Sizes." Anne was unable to attend, so Diane Van Kempen introduced Ms. Shoneman, a Master Level Nationally Accredited Flower Show Judge.
 - 1. Thelma was well-prepared, with each of her arrangements already started. She worked from smallest to largest, beginning with a "petite" presented against a 5"x5" background and working up to an arrangement large enough to top a pedestal.
 - 2. She demonstrated inventive use of birch bark as a diagonal presence in one arrangement, small dried curly-stemmed garlic scapes in another, grasses wrapped in metallic wire, and inserting stem ends of aspidistra leaves through slits in the leaf to create curling, flowing forms. A particular hit was using "deco beads" soaked in water as a filler to suspend items in a clear vase. When water was poured over the beads they disappeared, leaving the impression of orchids and limes suspended in water. It was delightful to see each design reach full expression through her patient additions of well-chosen plant material.
